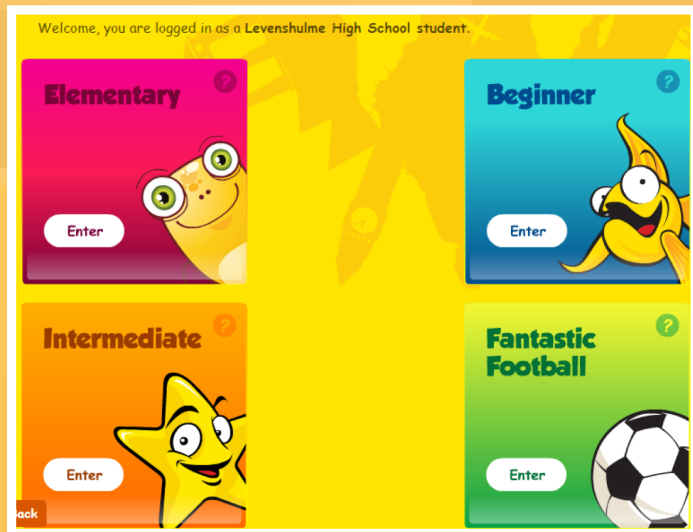


HOW TO USE LINGUASCOPE
