Dear Parents/Carers

Your daughter may already have talked to you about my news that I shared with the students in assemblies this week. I am writing now to explain this to you.

As you may know, I have been carrying out 2 roles since September 2019 – Executive Headteacher of our Trust of 3 schools and Headteacher at Levenshulme High School. This is no longer sustainable, it is too much for one person, especially as one of our schools currently needs more support. As a result, I am stepping down as Headteacher at Levenshulme High School in order to carry out fully the Executive Headteacher role. This will be at least until the end of 2020, possibly permanently.

Miss Johnson and Mr Johnson, who you may already know as Deputy Headteachers at Levenshulme, will be co-Headteachers from our return after half term and will lead the school together. They will, I know, ensure that Levenshulme continues to be the fantastic school that it is and I am sure that you will share my confidence.

I am incredibly proud of the school that Levenshulme has become, and the wonderful community that we have here. I will still be in and out of the school, working with senior leaders, and will never lose my sense of belonging to this special place.
