Partial closure of school - Wednesday 18th, Thursday 19th and Friday 20th March 2020

Due to the current situation across the UK, I am sorry to inform you that the school will be closed to all students in Year 8 and Year 9 for the above dates due to staff absence.

Students in years 7, 10 and 11 are expected to attend as normal, unless they are self-isolating following the government's advice. Please follow normal procedures for absence if your child will not be attending school on these days.
