<b>ASDAN: Bronze/Silver/Gold Award</b>
<p><b>Level of course:</b> This course is suitable for pupils of all abilities, <i>particularly those who may find some of the GCSE options too challenging.</i></p>
<p><b>Assessment Methods:</b> Students present a portfolio of evidence of their activities. This portfolio will contain:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• completed Personal and Social Development file and evidence of challenges completed</li> <li>• planning and reviewing documents</li> <li>• record of progress</li> <li>• summary of achievement, identifying skills development</li> </ul>
<p><b>Course content:</b> Students strive to earn 18 credits from the 13 modules that make up the Personal Development Programme and then compile a portfolio of evidence to showcase their achievements. The module titles are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Communication</li> <li>• The Community</li> <li>• Sport and Leisure</li> <li>• Home Management</li> <li>• The Environment</li> <li>• Number Handling</li> <li>• Health and Survival</li> <li>• World of Work</li> <li>• Science and Technology</li> <li>• The Wider World</li> <li>• Expressive Arts</li> <li>• Beliefs and Values</li> <li>• Combined Studies</li> </ul>
<p><b>Skills you need:</b> Ability to use PowerPoint, Word, and Excel, as well as to find information from multiple sources such as the internet, work effectively in groups, and complete tasks independently.</p>
<p><i>ASDAN is a pioneering curriculum that explicitly grows skills for learning, employment and skills for life.</i></p>
