ASDAN: Bronze/Silver/Gold Award

Level of course:

This course is suitable for pupils of all abilities, particularly those who may find some of the GCSE options too challenging.

Assessment Methods:

Students present a portfolio of evidence of their activities. This portfolio will contain:

- completed Personal and Social Development file and evidence of challenges completed
- planning and reviewing documents
- · record of progress
- summary of achievement, identifying skills development

Course content:

Students strive to earn 18 credits from the 13 modules that make up the Personal Development Programme and then compile a portfolio of evidence to showcase their achievements. The module titles are:

- Communication
- The Community
- Sport and Leisure
- Home Management
- The Environment
- Number Handling
- Health and Survival
- World of Work
- Science and Technology
- The Wider World
- Expressive Arts
- · Beliefs and Values
- Combined Studies

Skills you need:

Ability to use PowerPoint, Word, and Excel, as well as to find information from multiple sources such as the internet, work effectively in groups, and complete tasks independently.

ASDAN is a pioneering curriculum that explicitly grows skills for learning, employment and skills for life.

Skills you will acquire:

- This programme provides a real-life context to promote communication, personal skills and an awareness of the wider community in which we live.
- There is also a focus on numeracy, literacy, problem solving, ability to learn, teamwork and ICT skills

Progression routes and linked careers:

- Students may progress to study other ASDAN courses in college.
- ASDAN courses aim to support students in developing employability skills.
- Students may wish to continue to study Level 3 ASDAN courses at college.
